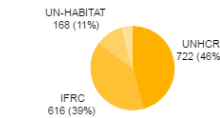

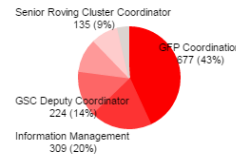

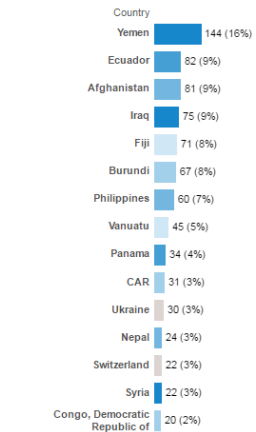
#### By function

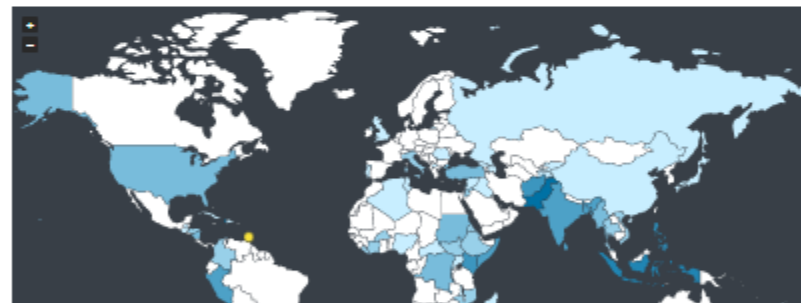
