



## NFI COMMON PIPELINE MONTHLY REPORT

### Darfur Distributions (1-31 October 2016)

During the reporting period, 6,190 households in North, South, and Central Darfur were provided with ES/ NFI items from the NFI Common Pipeline through implementing partners. A breakdown of distributions can be seen in the table below.

### NORTH DARFUR

#### Displacement due to Conflict:

##### ► Background

Around 4,500 households were reported to be displaced to Rawanda IDP camp in Tawila Locality, North Darfur, due to the armed conflict in Jabal Marra during the period between February- June. Some 4,157 households were verified during the reporting period and received ES/NFIs from the common pipeline through SRCS.

## SOUTH DARFUR

### Displacement due to Conflict:

#### ► Background

Around 700 households were reported to be displaced to Otash and Kass IDP camps in Nyala and Kass localities in South Darfur, due to the armed conflict in Jabal Marra during the period between February to June 2016. NCA and AOSCD verified 678 households during the reporting period and the displaced households received NFIs from the common pipeline through.

### Displacement due to Disaster: floods

#### ► Background

Some 375 households in Mershing , Manawashi and Dumma IDP camps in Mershing locality, South Darfur, were reported to have been displaced due to the destruction of their shelters by floods. ES/NFI assistance was provided to 359 households following verification by NCA.

#### ► Background

More than 650 households in Um Khair,Wadi Salih Locality , Central Darfur were reported to have been displaced due to the destruction of their shelters by heavy rains. ES/NFI assistance from the NFI Common Pipeline was provided to 619 households following verification.

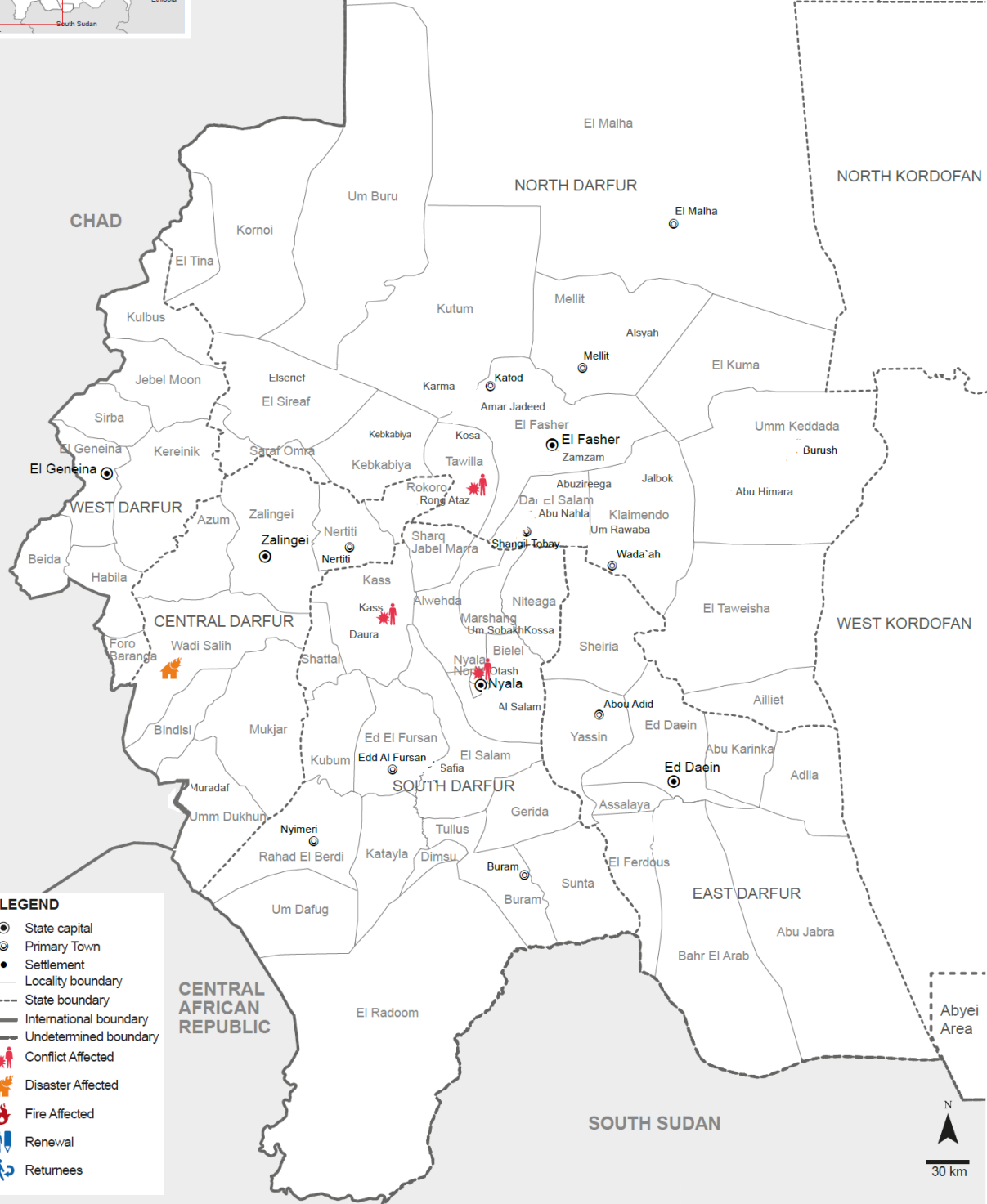

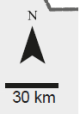


# SUDAN: Darfur - NFI & ES Response October
